## DEEP SEA DUEL

Rules:

- Players alternate choosing one card at a time.
- The winner is the first player to realize that he or she holds three cards with a sum of 15 .
- If all nine cards are chosen and neither player has three cards with a sum of 15 , then the game is a tie.

One additional variation that can be created involves fractions:
$1 / 6,5 / 24,1 / 4,7 / 24,1 / 3,3 / 8,5 / 12,11 / 12,1 / 2$

- The object of this game is to select three cards with a sum of $l$.
