

I'm thinking of a domino that....

Lay all (or a handful) of dominoes face up. Choose which one will be your secret domino but don't announce it out loud. Give clues such as "one side of the domino has twice the number of dots as the other does" or "the domino has a total number of dots less than 8" or "one side of the domino has an odd number of dots, the other has an even number." For each clue, encourage the child to remove all the dominoes that do not meet the criteria. Then switch players and let the child think up enough clues for you to figure out his or her secret number. The challenge of thinking up clues is a great one.
